#### Industrial Economy

\*Ministry of Science and Technology approved the National Blockchain Technology Innovation Center landed in Beijing Zhongguancun National Independent Innovation Demonstration Zone and was officially put into operation on May 10th which will accelerate the construction of super large-scale blockchain computing power cluster and form a digital infrastructure with strong performance.

\*Shenzhen government held a meeting to convey, study and implement the spirit of Xi Jinping's important speech at the first meeting of the 20th Central Financial and Economic Committee which pointed out to accelerate project recruitment around key industrial clusters such as NEV, energy storage, robots and new materials. Accelerate project construction, create the best industrial ecology and quickly form a modern industrial system that meets the requirements of high-quality development.

#### Policy

\*Ministry of Science and Technology and SASAC held a working conference which emphasized that central enterprises should be supported to meet the major needs of the state, focus on the "neck sticking" field, resolutely win the battle against key core technologies and effectively maintain the national industrial security. Guide central enterprises to put basic research in a more prominent position, increase investment in basic research and improve the original innovation ability.

\*The relevant departments recently issued a notice requesting each bank to control the notice of deposit, agreed deposit interest rate plus the upper limit. As for the notice of deposit interest rate, large state-owned banks cannot exceed the benchmark interest rate by 0.1 percentage point and other banks cannot exceed the benchmark interest rate by 0.2 percentage point.

\*CAAC: According to the preliminary statistics, in 2022, the total operating revenue of the whole industry reached cny 632.89bn, down 15.8% y/y. With aviation realized revenue from operations of cny 336.48bn, down 20.5% y/y, the airport realized revenue of cny 77.01bn, down 18.5% y/y, the whole industry completed passenger traffic volume of 251.7mio, down 42.9% y/y.

\* Precious metals closed mixed. COMEX gold contract down 0.3% to closed at \$2036.8/oz. SHFE gold active contract up 0.22% to closed at 455.22 yuan/gram.

\* Metals closed down collectively, LME nickel down 4.45%, LME aluminum down 2.18%, LME zinc down 2.13%. SHFE nickel down 4.01%, SHFE zinc down 1.21%, bonded copper down 1.14%.

\* Commodity futures closed down collectively. Energy & chemistry futures saw weak
