## \*Key points

#### Macro:

\*The executive meeting of the State Council proposed to deploy phased tax deferment measures for small, medium-sized and micro enterprises in the manufacturing industry. In addition, in order to alleviate the operating difficulties of coal-fired power and heating enterprises, the tax deferment for the fourth quarter of this year was implemented

### Financial:

\*Premier Li Keqiang presided over the executive meeting of the State Council, which decided to extend the preferential tax policies for foreign investors to invest in the domestic bond market, promote opening to the outside world and attract foreign investment

### Industrial:

- \*NDRC held a special meeting to study the specific measures of coal price intervention.
- \*NDRC and State Administration for Market Regulation jointly carried out special supervision on coal spot market prices and severely investigated and dealt with violations of laws and regulations.

### **Commodities (night session):**

- \* EIA: as of the week of October 22, 2021, US crude oil reserve increased by 4268 thousand barrels, more than expectation. Global crude oil price rose collectively. December NYMEX crude oil contract fell 3.05% to closed at \$82.07/b. December Brent contract declined 2.64% to closed at \$83.39/b, INE crude oil active contract quoted 1.56% lower to closed at 523.4 yuan/b.
- \* The fall of global bond yield led to concerns over economic growth. COMEX gold futures closed at \$1798.3/oz (up 0.27%), COMEX silver futures closed at \$24.125/oz (up 0.15%). SHFE gold active contract closed at 370.52 yuan/gram (up 0.54%), silver closed at 4935 yuan/Kilogram (up 0.37%).
- \* Metals closed down collectively. LME aluminum slumped 5.78% to \$2665.5/ton, tin fell 6.99% to \$34805/ton, copper declined 2.2% to \$9573.5 /ton, zinc fell 2.44% to \$3341.5/ton. SHFE tin plummeted 8.00% to 258370 yuan/ton, aluminum down 6.33% to 19465 yuan/ton, copper down 1.88% to 70110 yuan/ton, bonded copper down 2.07% to 62320 yuan/ton.
- \* NDRC called meeting with China National Coal Association and some of the key enterprises to discuss the interference measures on coal price, black series futures fell collectively, with thermal coal, coke and coking coal all slumped to lower price limit, hot-rolled coil down 5.07%, steel rebar down 3.92%.
- \* Energy & chemistry sector saw weak performance, methanol plummeted 10.92%, glass went down 6.15%. Agriculture commodity futures saw diverge performance, RBD palm olein declined 0.98%, soybean oil down 1.05%, rapeseed meal up 1.96%.





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
