- *Premier Li Keqiang chaired the State Council general meeting and approved the professional technique training plan during the 14th 5-year plan period which said to accelerate cultivation of qualified labor and talents.
- *Cylindrical lithium battery core to see price lifted again in early 2022 by 5-15%, according to battery module plant and reported by DIGITIMES.
- *CPCAAUTO: retail sales of passenger vehicle during Nov 15th to 21st of 345k units, down 12% y/y, up 6% vs last week and down 6% m/m.

Commodities (night session):

- * EIA: US strategic oil reserve logged at 602.6 million barrels, the lowest since May, 2003. Global crude oil price continued to fall. January NYMEX crude oil contract down 0.71% to closed at \$65.71/b, February Brent contract down 0.26% to closed at \$69.05/b, INE crude oil active contract down 0.45% to closed at 442.7 yuan/b.
- * COMEX gold futures closed at \$1783.1/oz (up 0.37%). SHFE gold active contract closed at 367.82 yuan/gram (down 0.21%).
- * Metals performed mixed. LME aluminum up 0.88%, copper down 0.74%. SHFE aluminum down 0.39%, copper down 0.59%, bonded copper down 0.71%.
- * Commodity futures performed mixed. Energy & chemistry sector saw diverge performance, with ethenylbenzene up 2.79%, soda ash up 1.7%, PVC down 2.66%, TSR 20 down 2.42%. For black series, steel rebar up 0.57%, coke up 0.44%, whereas thermal coal down 1.25%, coking coal down 1%. Agriculture commodity futures performed mixed, cotton up 1.58%, rapeseed meal down 1.09%.

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
